



SUMMER CAMP PICK UP/DROP OFF BUS SERVICE

We are offering a pick up/drop off service by bus on **Sundays only** during all summer camp dates. A Killary staff member will accompany the campers to and from the pickup points.

Dublin:

Meeting point: Heuston Train Station – at the information point door which is just before you access/exit the train lines.

Pick up time is at 2.45 - 3pm

Depart Dublin at 3pm. Arrive at Killary Adventure Company at 7.30pm

For the return trip:

Depart Killary Adventure Company at 9.00am. Arrive in Dublin at 1.30pm

En-route there will also be meeting points at:

Athlone - 5.00-5.30pm pick up point for Athlone, at the Filling Station called Kilmartin N6 Centre, Dublin Road, Athlone, which is just off the motor way on the outskirts of Athlone on the Dublin side.

Galway – 6.00 – 6.30pm Dunnes Stores, Terryland Shopping Centre, Headford Rd, Galway - at front door.

For the return trip:

Depart Killary Adventure Company at 9.00am. Arrive in Galway at 10.30am / Athlone 11.45am

DUBLIN AIRPORT

We can also collect your child to and from Dublin Airport on Sundays.

Our airport transfers operate on Sundays only.

We will pick up your child and bring them to Dublin Heuston Train station for meeting with the bus to Killary.

For Dublin Airport transfers, you will need to make sure that your child's flight times are before 12.00pm on arrival to Dublin and depart Dublin after 5pm, so we can link with the Killary bus. The cost is €295.00 return.

There is a direct bus from Dublin Airport to Dublin's Heuston Station (Airlink 747). The journey time is about 21 minutes, so if you and your child are happy to get this to Heuston Station they would meet up with our bus there. Tickets can be pre-purchased online. In the event of flight delays

In the event of a child's flight being delayed significantly to Dublin Airport, this would mean they would miss our Dublin to Killary transfer bus. There is no direct public transport to and from Killary Adventure Centre. The Killary Airport person would put the children on a public bus from Dublin Airport to Galway City Bus Station and they would travel unaccompanied with your permission. The children would then take a pre-booked registered taxi from Galway City bus station directly to Killary Adventure Centre. The taxi would be organised by the Killary Airport person while in Dublin Airport.

Our Airport person may be collecting a group of children from different flights. In the event of significant flight delays for even one child, all airport transfer children for that day would travel the alternative plan together. If one is late for the Killary bus they are all going to be late as our Airport person must wait in the Airport with all the children together. All these additional costs will be incurred by the parents.

The cost of a bus from Dublin Airport to Galway City is approximately €10 -15 euros. We would use either of the following public transport; Citilink, Go bus, or Bus Eireann. The cost of the taxi from Galway City to Killary Adventure Centre is €100.00 approximately. If there is more than one child travelling from Dublin Airport, as there usually is, the cost of the taxi would be shared amongst the parents.

By booking an Airport transfer you are agreeing to the back-up plan to get your child to Killary Adventure Centre.

If you live outside Ireland and would like your child to attend our Summer-camp, another option to consider is travelling over with your child to meet our Killary bus at Dublin Heuston for 2.45pm.

Please note All transfers have to be booked at least two weeks in advance of your booking date and payment will be required in full. There is limited space on the bus, and that is why bookings have to be made in advance.

We have a mobile phone which will be specific for Dublin/Athlone/Galway Summercamp transfers. This mobile will be carried by the person who is doing the collecting / drop off, for the Dublin/Athlone/GalwaySummercamp. In the event of any changes to the booking on THE DAY (delayed / cancelled), you have to ring the Summercamp mobile, and similarly if we are delayed we will contact you. The Summercamp phone for transfers operates on the Sunday from 9am – 7.30pm. For all other details of the camp, you contact the main centre on 095-43411. The Airport transfers can contact a different number. They contact the Airport person directly on the day.

DIRECTIONS FROM GALWAY TO KILLARY ADVENTURE CO - [GOOGLE MAP](#)

Follow the signs for the N59 Clifden passing through the towns of Moycullen and Oughterard. You will arrive at Maam Cross (Peacock's hotel complex on your right), turn right at crossroads onto the R336, following the signs for Leenane.

At the next T-junction, at Keane's Pub, turn left. You are continuing on the R336.

Enter village of Leenane keep left at junction.

Taking the Clifden Road the N59 (keep the water on your right hand side) we are 5km along road on the left hand side.

DIRECTIONS FROM WESTPORT TO KILLARY ADVENTURE CO – [GOOGLE MAP](#)

Take the N59 Leenane/Clifden road and follow it for about 30kms to the village of Leenane.

Continue over the bridge and turning right, and through Leenane on the Clifden road (N59) keeping the Killary Fjord on your right and we are 5km along this road on the left hand side.
