



WALKING WEEKEND IN KILLARY FOR JUNE BANK HOLIDAY 2018

DAY 1: Friday 1st June 2018

Arrive to Killary and check in. Overnight accommodation
Unpack & relax for the evening.

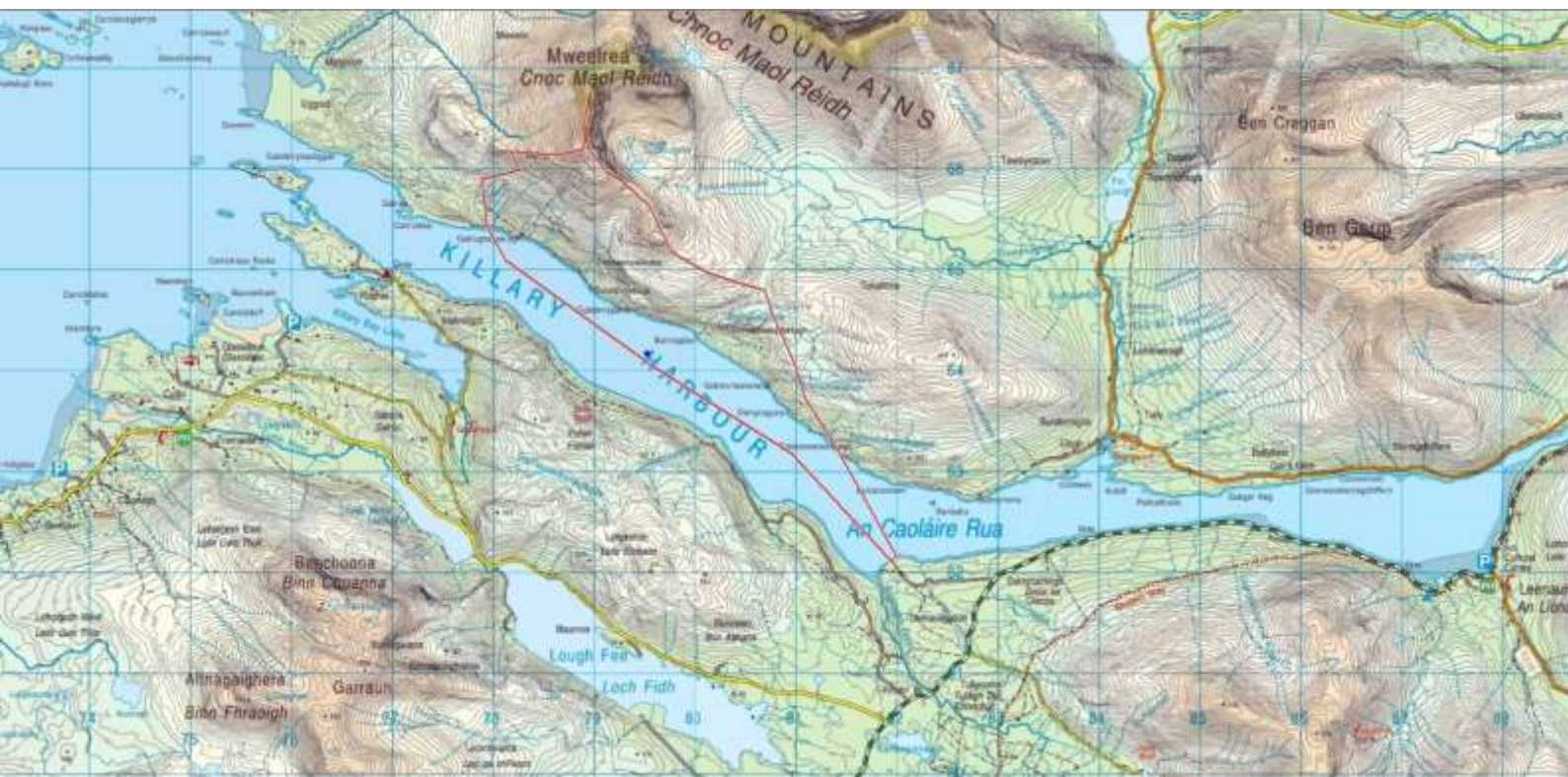
DAY 2: Saturday 2nd June 2018

8.00: Breakfast & taking a packed lunch with you.

Full day walk on Mweelrea.

Speedboat out to famine village at base of Mweelrea and then a climb up and walk back to Pats Crag. 13.7KM in total. This is a committing hike up Connacht's highest mountain. Starting off at the pier in Killary you will get dropped off at the base of Mweelrea on the site of an old Famine village. From here you will take a little used route up the West side of the mountain and onto the summit ridge. You will follow the summit ridge along to the top before retracing your route back down along the Northern edge of Killary fjord. You will finish up at the base of Pats crag a popular climbing hangout for rock climbers. From here you will re embark your boat for the final trip back to the Killary pier.

DAY 3: Sunday 3rd June 2018

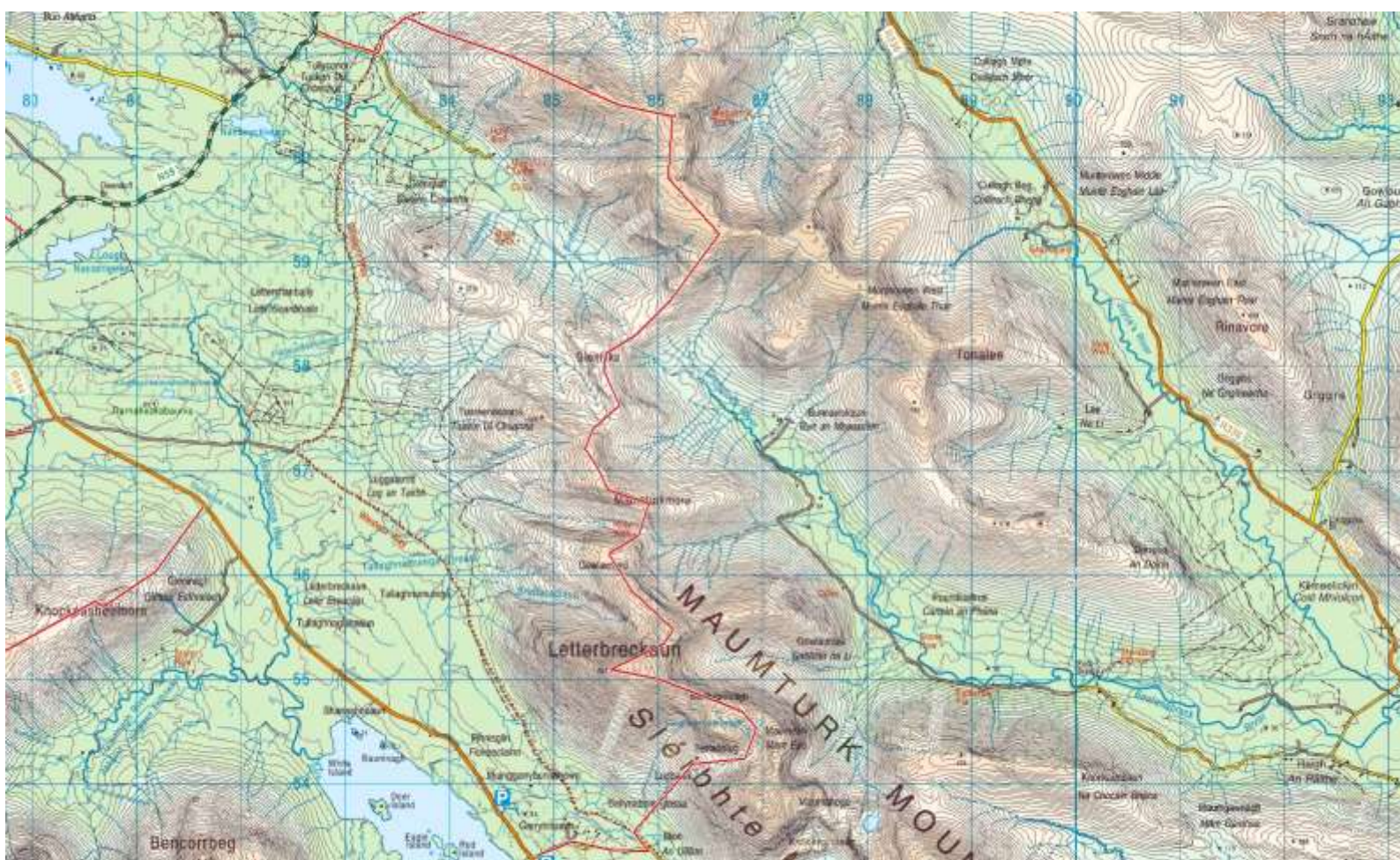
8.00: Breakfast & taking a packed lunch with you

Full day walk: Letterbreckan - Killary via 6 summits on the Maum Turks. 15.6KM

Starts at Lough Inagh lodge and goes up towards Maumean before turning left to summit Letterbreckan at 667m. From there we go along to Maumturkmore and on across to Gleniska. From here you go up the very aptly named Col of Despondency en route to your next summit at 578m. From there you hit two more summits before you last one at 550m. From here it is a steep descent back down to Killary while trying to watch your feet and not the spectacular views of Killary Fjord. This route follows a large part of the popular Maum Turks challenge route and is a good test of the fitness in your legs.

19.00 – 20.00: Dinner – 2 course evening meal

Overnight accommodation
