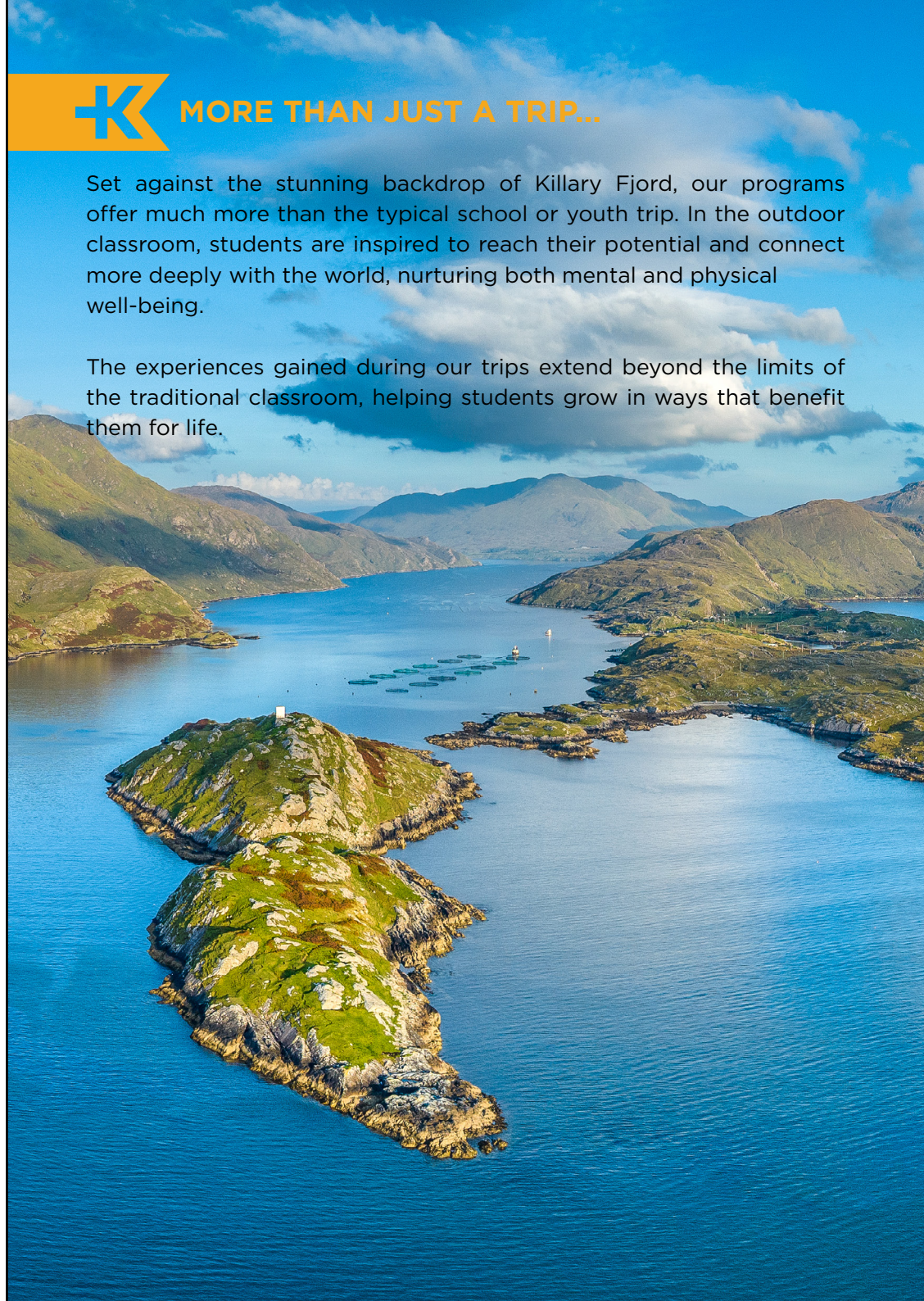

- **Bronze Award:** 25-30km walking. This walk can usually be achieved in 1.5 days

- **Silver Award:** 50-79km walking. This walk can usually be achieved in 2 days

Our school residential programmes are suitable for students from 8+ years. All programmes include breakfast, lunch, dinner, activities, evening games and 24-hour supervision.

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At Killary Adventure Co., we are committed to preserving Connemara through sustainable practices and community involvement. Key initiatives include:

- **B Corp Certification (March 2024):** Reflects our commitment to balancing profit with purpose and sustainability.
- **Heating & Hot Water:**
 - 200kW biomass boiler fueled by locally sourced wood (within 5km).
 - Goal to be fossil fuel-free by 2026.
- **Electricity:**
 - 6kW wind turbine and 32kW solar farm.
 - Additional 8kW of solar panels and a 10kW battery installed in 2024.
- **Food Waste:**
 - 100% composted on-site with a Ridan compost machine.
 - Upgraded to a Harp renewable electric food composter in 2024.
- **Tree Planting:**
 - 500 trees planted annually since 2018.
 - Continued planting with 500 trees in February 2024.
- **Waste Management & Recycling:**
 - On-site recycling centre for bottles, cans, paper, and cardboard.
 - No plastic bags in bins; youth groups encouraged to sort waste before departure.
- **Innovative Practices:**
 - Experimenting with sustainable building materials, including hemp blocks.
 - Reducing single-use plastics and aiming for zero-waste events.
 - Testing biochar for use in tree planting and greenhouses.
- **Visitor Engagement:**
 - Encouraging visitors to follow our green philosophy by sorting waste, reusing, and recycling where possible.
